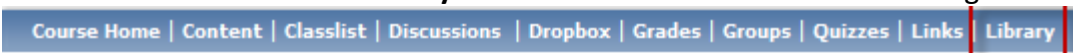


Using the Library Course Pages Link

The **Library Link** takes you to a homegrown UW Colleges tool called **Library Course Pages**. They are designed to provide students with a one-stop shop for course resources. Every course created in Desire2Learn has the **Library Link**. It is located on the lower left navigation bar.



Here is an example of a default page designed to provide students with the basics necessary to access the necessary information for their course at their campus library.
